COVID-19 Safety Update

We are looking forward to our first Emerging Franchisor in-person gathering in over a year! IFA continues to place top priority on safety for all those attending the **2021 Emerging Franchisor Conference**.

Your safety is our number one goal. Here's what we're doing to make sure you stay safe:

- Per New Orleans, LA regulations ([Current Guidelines effective October 27, 2021](#)) the following applies:
 - **Mask Requirements:** Unvaccinated individuals should wear a mask in public indoor spaces
 - **Vaccine Requirements:** Proof of at least one dose of an approved COVID vaccine or negative PCR/antigen test within 72 hours is required at all indoor gatherings at the following establishments:
 - Event spaces such as hotel ballrooms, event venues & reception halls, restaurants, bars, gyms, indoor group fitness classes, indoor entertainment/ amusement facilities
 - Closest testing sites from the hotel:
 - Tulane Medical Center – 0.8 miles away
1415 Tulane Ave, New Orleans, LA 70112
 - Walgreen's – 1.6 miles away
1100 Elysian Fields Ave, New Orleans, LA 70117
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available in multiple locations
- Small group attendance to allow for distancing
- Physical distancing of three feet when indoors whenever possible
- Attendees will be provided wrist bands indicating their level of personal comfort with distance and engagement:
 - **Red** – “I Need Distance”
 - **Yellow** – “Elbow Bump”
 - **Green** – “Hugs & High Fives”
- If you are showing any symptoms of COVID-19 or have had contact with anyone who has tested positive in the last two weeks, please stay home

In partnership with **Royal Sonesta New Orleans**, IFA will provide:

- Responsible food & beverage/seating/barriers for meeting spaces
- Appropriate signage to reinforce spatial distancing and other safety reminders
