

COVID-19 Safety Update

We are looking forward to our next in-person gathering! IFA continues to place top priority on safety for all those attending the **2022 IFA ANNUAL CONVENTION**.

Your safety is our number one goal. Here's what we're doing to make sure you stay safe:

- Per California State regulations ([CA.gov](https://www.ca.gov)) the following applies:
 - **Mask Requirements:** Masks are only required for unvaccinated individuals in all indoor public settings but are highly encouraged for all attendees.
 - **Vaccine Requirements:** Proof of full COVID vaccine or negative COVID-19 PCR test within 48 hours or a negative COVID-19 antigen test within 24 hours is required at all indoor gatherings of 1000 people including conventions, conferences, expos, large private events or gatherings
 - In Partnership with Reel Health, COVID vaccine and test results will be checked prior to entry of the building.
 - You must show your proof of vaccination or proof of negative test results upon entry. All adult attendees must provide I.D. to confirm the individual presenting proof of vaccination or negative test is the attendee entering the facility or venue.
 - For a list of nearby testing facilities please refer to the IFA Convention Mobile App.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available in multiple locations
- Small group attendance to allow for distancing
- Physical distancing of three feet when indoors, whenever possible
- Attendees will be offered optional red wrist bands indicating their level of personal comfort with distance and engagement indicating "I Need Distance"
- If you are showing any symptoms of COVID-19 or have had contact with anyone who has tested positive in the last two weeks, please stay home

In partnership with the **San Diego Convention Center** and **Hyatt Manchester San Diego Hotel**, IFA will provide:

- Responsible food & beverage/seating/barriers for meeting spaces
- Appropriate signage to reinforce spatial distancing and other safety reminders

IFA will continue to monitor local and CDC guidance and provide updates where needed. This document will continue to be updated as more information becomes available or if the situation changes.
