



## **International Franchise Association Foundation Scholarship** **Sponsored by the Stewart and Jane Bainum Fund of the** **Community Foundation**

The International Franchise Association Foundation and the Stewart and Jane Bainum Fund of the Community Foundation have partnered to sponsor this scholarship award. A competitive one-time award will be presented annually. Additionally, the individual selected will receive a travel stipend (up to \$1500) to attend the International Franchise Association's (IFA) Annual Convention and participate in NextGen in Franchising programming.

### **Who Can Apply?**

To be eligible for this one-time award, applicant must: (1) be enrolled in an U.S. accredited college or university with studies in business, hospitality or franchise management, (2) have sophomore, junior or senior college class standing for the period of the scholarship and (3) be a U.S. citizen.

### **How Can the Awards Be Used?**

The award is to be used for tuition, books and applicable academic fees.

### **How Do You Get Started?**

Students must complete the International Franchise Association Foundation Scholarship application form, submit an official academic transcript and prepare a short typed essay (no more than 500-words) on "Why a College Education is Still Relevant." Incomplete packages will not be reviewed.

### **Application Procedure**

Applications are accepted between **August 1<sup>st</sup> and October 31<sup>st</sup>**. The completed application and supporting materials must be received in a **single packet by October 31<sup>st</sup>** and mailed to: IFA Foundation, 1900 K Street, NW, Suite #700, Washington, DC 20006.

- Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen
Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited college/university in the U.S. with course of study in Business, Hospitality or Franchise Management
Applicant must have sophomore, junior or senior class status for the period of the scholarship

- Submit an official certified (raised-seal) transcript.
Prepare a 500-word essay on "Why a College Education is Still Relevant"
Applications are accepted between August 1st and October 31st deadline.
